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## **FFC Assistance of Govt. Primary & Secondary Schools, Goth Machhi and Jhampir**

FFC through its CSR Program is committed to the provision of quality education to the underprivileged and deprived children in the proximity of FFC plant site. In 2014 a comprehensive infrastructure uplift and rehabilitation program was successfully concluded for over 50 schools in GM and Jhampir. A few of these intervention are as following:

- Construction of new class rooms and associated facilities at Govt. Girls Primary School Wahid Buksh Lar
- Uplift of 3 Primary School through infrastructure development at Jhampir
- Uplift of Govt. Higher Secondary School Old, Sadiqabad

## **FFC collaboration with Tameer Millat Foundation (TMF)**

TMF is a reputed not for profit organization which is working for the provision of cost effective & quality education to the talented and deserving students from across Pakistan. To supplement TMF contribution for this noble cause, FFC extended its donation to TMF in 2014 which is as following.

- 5 x vehicles for the transportation of students and faculty
- Full sponsorship to 5 x talented and deserving student for their 3 years Diploma of Associate

Engineering programs which is inclusive of their boarding and lodging

#### **Collaboration with Leading Academia and Educational institutes**

FFC CSR in 2014 further enhance its networking and association with leading academia for the provision of quality education to the talented and deserving student on merit basis. Few notable collaboration are as following.

##### 1) **LUMS**

FFC continued with its support to 2 x students at Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS) through its National Outreach Program. Till now Rs 3.6 million have been extended to LUMS to cover entire academic, living and associated expenses of the sponsored students.

##### 2) **NAMAL College**

NAMAL education foundation is providing quality education to the deserving and talented student on merit basis through NAMAL College, Mianwali. NAMAL college is an associated campus of University of Bradford. In 2014, FFC extended its complete sponsorship to 2 x students at NAMAL for four year degree program with a donation of Rs 2.4 million.

##### 3) **FC College**

Forman Christian College, Lahore is among the top ranking educational institutes in Pakistan which through its student support program offers full time scholarship to the talented and deserving students. FFC is presently sponsoring 7 x student for their education and associated expenses at FC College. In 2014 FFC extended Rs. 1.83 million for the subject sponsorship.

##### 4) **Cadet Colleges**

FFC extended its sponsorship to Cadet College Larkana through provision of infrastructure facility for resident cadets in 2014. Also, FFC collaborated with Cadet College Hassan Abdal for the provision of ambulance for institute medical needs. Since 2012, FFC sponsored talented and deserving student of district Ghotki at Cadet College Ghotki. By 2014 18 x student are enrolled at Cadet College Ghotki being fully sponsored by FFC.

##### 5) **Wards of Farmer Scholarship**

FFC awards Wards of Farmer scholarship annually to talented and deserving students from across Pakistan. The scholarship program covers disciplines including Post Matric, Higher Education and MBBS. In 2014, 73 new scholarships were awarded to an existing list of 145 students on merit basis. This is in addition to 40 merit scholarships awarded to students from Tehsil Sadiqabad and Mirpur Mathelo annually.

The campus is expected to cater the needs of locals for education of the population for generation to come.



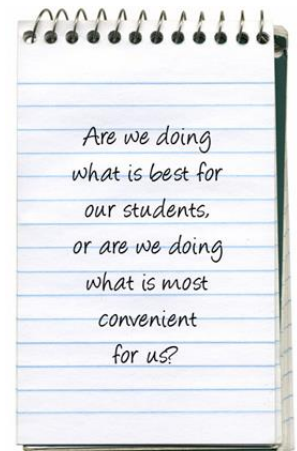
## FFC Wards of Farmer Scholarship Program 2014

FFC has initiated the 10<sup>th</sup> season of its annual scholarship program for the talented & deserving “Wards of Farmers” from across Pakistan. The season kicked- off in April and it is expected to provide financial assistance to 73 x more students for a period up to four years.

Upon selection, the portfolio of students enrolled in the Wards of Farmers Program will increase up to 243 x students with a profile cost of Rs. 8.8 Million.

FFC has put its emphasis on education at grass roots level. In the past few years FFC has taken many initiatives in order to improve quality and accessibility to education around the plant sites as follows:

- Sona Public School
- Sona Computer Institute
- Scholarship Program
- Adopted and Assisted Schools in Goth Macchi and Mirpur Mathelo



## **Sona Public School**



Sona Public School (SPS) was constructed by FFC in 2007. School has classes from KG to VII and will be starting VIII class from 2011. Total number of enrolled students availing this facility stands at 362 with a teaching staff of 18. The school provides quality education to the natives of Tehsil Mirpur Mathelo, with negligible fee. The school has science labs, library, resource centre and computer lab among other notable facilities like pick and drop for students. SPS has in a short time established its reputation in the surrounding vicinities and is an example of FFC commitment to the welfare of underprivileged communities of District Ghotki. Adding another feather to it's basket of success, students from SPS have made their way to reputable cadet college last year and INSHALLAH future will bring more success in its direction.

## **Sona Computer Institute**



Sona Computer Institute (SCI) was constructed in 2009. It was registered with Sindh Board of Technical Education, Karachi to provide maximum benefit to the students and have their education recognized. A total of 107 students have been trained in various courses so far. Students at SCI have qualified IT experts at their disposal while the institute has a highly equipped computer lab with 40 latest computers. SCI has been recognized for its excellence and the institute has the honor of providing 6 months courses in the reduced time frame of 3 months, credited to its faculty and state of the art facilities available at SCI.

## Scholarships

The foremost opportunity to empower the community in areas around the plant is imparting education. FFC has been encouraging education to the less privileged talented youth by providing them scholarship. Scholarship is granted under three different categories including

- Scholarship to the wards of the farmers
- Merit scholarships for the students of districts Ghotki and Rahim Yar Khan
- Children of FFC employees



Every year, FFC awards a combined quota of 184 scholarships under its scholarship program at a cost of 4million (PKR). In future this program will be extended in order to accommodate more students, thus assisting them in changing their future. Scholarships are offered in the following categories:

- Post Metric
- Post Intermediate
- Post Graduate
- Professional Studies including CA, Medical, Engineering, MBA, MSc/BSc Computer Sciences
- Higher Studies including Mphil/ Phd

### **Adopted and Assisted Schools in Goth Macchi and Mirpur Mathelo**



FFC not only runs its own school but it also has taken responsibility of 14 schools in districts Rahim Yar Khan and Ghotki, in partnership with the local government. The standard is being raised by providing resources to improve the quality of education as well as general administration. FFC is also assisting more than 25 government schools in these districts for stationary, infrastructure and teaching aids. This adoption program is a milestone for FFC initiative of providing education to every child in the surrounding localities of FFC plant sites in Goth Macchi and Mirpur Mathelo. In order to provide quality education, FFC has provided them teachers, so that the students of these areas are able to improve their standard.



Special attention has been paid to the girl schools so that education can be provided to the women folk who make up 51% of Pakistan's population, but face discrimination in many sectors. The students have shown extra ordinary commitment and 3 of them have acquired distinction in the field of Arts, Debate and Naat competition held at district level. Books, uniform and teaching aid is also provided to the students under this program while the teaching staff is trained every year under special coaching program for higher efficiency.
