

FFC CSR - Al Shifa Eye Trust to Collaborate for 5 Free Eye Camp

Provision of quality health care to the underprivileged and remote communities has been central to FFC CSR program. Keeping in line with this commitment, FFC in collaboration with Al Shifa Eye Trust Hospital will be arranging 5 free eye camps in 2013, reaching out to the remote and far flung communities in district Rawalpindi.



The 1st eye camp was held on 24th June 2013 at Government Boys High School Chak Beli Khan. The camp attracted patients in large number, suffering from various eye complications. In all 807 patients were treated at the camp with 419 male and 388 female patients. 498 patient's received vision glasses from the doctors on spot whereas 24 patients were referred and transferred to Al Shifa Eye Trust for Inter Ocular Lens (IOL) replacement. FFC and Al Shifa plans to reach out to 4000 eye patients from the remote and far flung communities of Rawalpindi district in 2013 through this initiative.
