FFC Flood Relief Efforts

- Pakistan's Southern parts witnessed unprecedented rains followed by devastated floods in Year 2022. Complete Nation got mobilized to support the flood affectees. FFC through its plant sites at Goth Machhi and Mirpur Mathelo stood with the flood affactees right from the day one in relief works followed by major rehabilitation activities
- Apart from FFC contributions (Rs 350 Million) all FFC employees also contributed
 Rs 12 Million plus for the noble cause.
- Flood relief strategy was planned in two phases:-
 - Short Term Measures. These include medical camps, medicines for livestock, ration distribution, water hand pumps installation and provision of mosquito nets. Following measures were taken:-
 - 7 x Medical camps were conducted & assistance provided to 1850 patients of local population in GM/MM.





Vet Medicines were provided to 150 x Livestock holders.





• 3,768 ration bags were distributed at different location surrounding GM&MM.





- 400 x Packs comprising household items were distributed.
- An RO Plant & 217 water hand pumps were installed for clean water.
- 900 people of flood hit areas were provided with mosquito nets.

■ Long term Measures. These include repair & construction of 336 x houses (work in progress at full swing), repair/ re-construction of 22 x damaged schools. Repair/re-construction 2 x basic health units. MD&CEO inspected the flood rehabilitation works in Mirpur Mathelo surrounding areas. He appreciated the efforts and further pledged to continue same efforts for the needy ones. MD&CEO FFC handed over the newly constructed houses to the flood affectees.
