Mr. Waseem Ajmal Chaudhry, hailing from Lahore qualified as an Engineer from University of Engineering & Technology, Lahore and joined premier Civil Service of Pakistan in 1992.

He has served for more than 25 Years at significant positions notably Deputy Commissioner Faisalabad and Mianwali, and worked as EDO Finance. For three years he was engaged with Asian Developmental Bank on promotion of sustainable livelihoods in the Barani Areas of Punjab.

As Founding Member and first MD of Lahore Waste Management Company, he led transformation of the entire paradigm of the Waste Management System.
